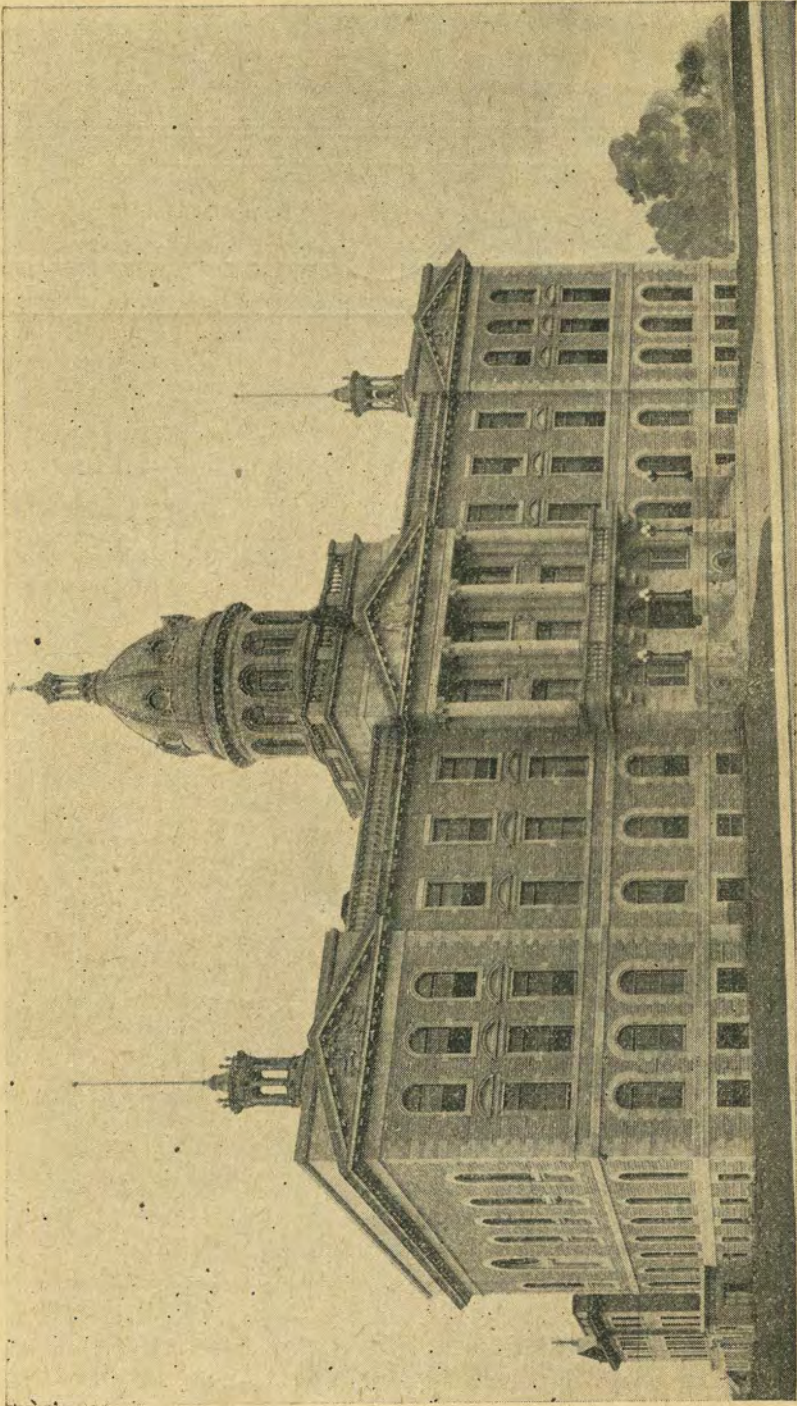

## PROSPECTUS

---

The St. Boniface College, placed under the patronage of St. Joseph, is the oldest educational institution in the Northwest. Its aim is to form men of sound culture, virtuous habits and deep religious convictions, whose influence must eventually make itself felt in the clergy, in liberal professions and in civic and political circles, as well as in industry, commerce, and the other non-professional walks in life.

St. Boniface College is an integral factor in the University by the same right and on the same footing as the other Colleges, St. John's, Manitoba and Wesley. The College has its representatives on the Council and Board of Studies of the University and on different Examiners' Committees.

**CLASSICAL COURSE.** This course is divided into two parts: the College Course, comprising three years, and devoted especially to the study of English, French, Latin and Greek Grammar, of History and Mathematics, and the Arts Course, comprising four years and leading to B.A. degree.

**COMMERCIAL COURSE.** This course has a compass of three years, after which pupils who have succeeded in the final examinations are awarded a Diploma of Accountant.

**PREPARATORY COURSE.** Students applying for admission to the College, if found deficient in the qualifications required for the Classical or the Commercial Course, must first go through the Preparatory, which may last one or two years, as circumstances may require.

### GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Students must be provided with all necessary toilet articles and clothing.
2. Parents will be held responsible for any damage done to college property, such as breaking window panes, defacing walls or desks, etc.



3. All literature brought from outside, in the form of books, magazines or newspapers, will have to be approved by the Prefect of Discipline.

4. The students' correspondence is subject to the inspection of the Prefect of Discipline.

5. Visitors are received in the parlor on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays from 2.30 o'clock to 5 o'clock.

6. The students shall not leave the premises of the College without leave of the Prefect of Discipline.

7. All vulgarity, whether in speech or in manners, as well as habitual and prolonged laziness will not be tolerated.

8. Permission to go into the city will be rarely granted to boarders and only for serious reasons; the same rule is applied to all those sleeping at college.

9. The use of tobacco in any form is forbidden.

10. Notice is hereby given to all concerned that students who refuse to obey their masters, who habitually break the rules of the College, who leave the premises without proper authorization, whose moral conduct is not satisfactory, who have an evil influence over their fellow-students, who neglect habitually their religious duties or their studies, may be dismissed without further notice.

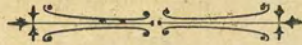
